Friday, December 12th at 11am

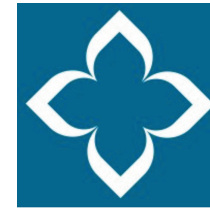
Join the activities department and your neighbors in welcoming student volunteers from Shroder High School. They are bringing small gifts to hand out and playing pokeno!



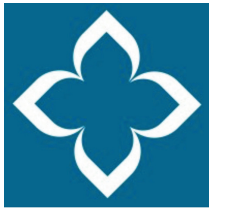
New Year Celebration
