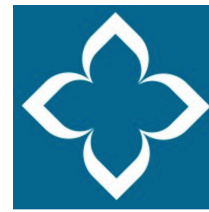

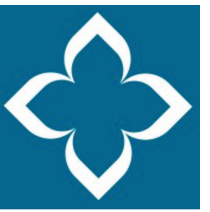

graveyard!

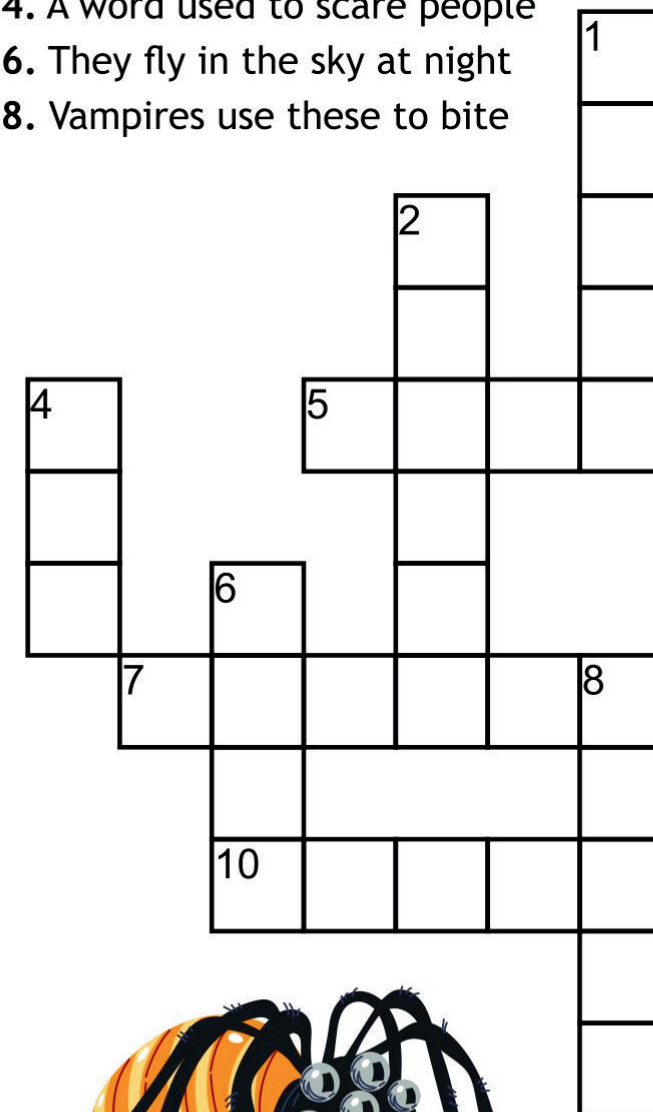
